Privacy Policy

This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for www.hosannahouse.org. This privacy policy applies solely to the information collected by this website. This policy will notify you of the following:

1. What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the web site, how it is used and with whom it may be shared.
2. What choices are available to you regarding the use of the data.
3. The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
4. How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to collect information that you give to us by filling out online donation and volunteer forms, program registration, event registration, and making payments. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

We will use this information to respond to your online activity on our website. We will not share your information with any third party outside our organization. However, we may share your personal information if we have a good faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of such information is reasonably necessary to (a) satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request, (b) enforce applicable Terms of Service, including investigation of potential violations thereof, (c) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues, or (d) protect against imminent harm to the rights, property or safety of Hosanna House, its users or the public as required or permitted by law.

Unless you ask us not to, we may also use this information to inform you of Hosanna House fundraising opportunities, volunteer opportunities, and programs.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

Web Beacons

When you visit our website, we may collect, either directly or through third-party service providers (such as Google Analytics), certain technical and navigational information, such as computer browser type, IP address, network used, device used, pages visited, date of visit, geo demographics of visitors, new or returning visitors, and average time spent on our website. We analyze this information, with the assistance of our service

providers, to improve our web design and functionality, to enhance our ability to serve you and to tailor our communications to you regarding our services.

Cookies

We use “cookies” on this site. A cookie is a piece of data stored on a site visitor’s hard drive to help us improve your access to our site and identify repeat visitors to our site. For instance, when we use a cookie to identify you, you would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Cookies can also enable us to track and target the interest of our users to enhance the experience on our site. Usage of cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information on our site.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit personally identifiable information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Whenever a payment is made through our website, the credit card information is processed by a third party and only the last four digits of that information is forwarded to Hosanna House. To receive more information about the credit card processing company, click the payment button on our website and select that company’s icon.

Whenever we collect personally identifiable information (such as names, addresses), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for “https” at the beginning of the address of the web page.

We also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, accounting or development) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.
