Hosanna House, Inc. (HHI) is closely monitoring all updates on the coronavirus (COVID-19) and consulting on public health recommendations with the Allegheny County Health Department and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention.

Hosanna House CDC, we will follow the Governor's mandate requiring us to be closed through April 8, 2020. Since the Easter holiday begins April 10, 2020, we plan to open our doors on April 13, 2020. At the end of that time, HHI will re-evaluate the situation and make further closure decisions accordingly.
