

Hosanna House, Inc. CEO Leon Haynes on COVID-19 UPDATE



Hosanna House, Inc. (HHI) is closely monitoring all updates on the coronavirus (COVID-19) and consulting on public health recommendations with the Allegheny County Health Department and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention.

PA Governor Tom Wolf announced that all Pennsylvania K-12 schools and daycare centers will close for 10 business days in response to COVID-19 outbreaks. As a result, the Child Development Center at HHI will be closed until March 27, 2020. Other services that will be closed during the same time:

- *Afterschool Programs*
- *Intramural Sports*
- *Swimming*
- *Water Aerobics*
- *Pound Classes*

At the end of that time, HHI will re-evaluate the situation and make further closure decisions accordingly.

We ask visitors to observe the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control (<http://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019.ncov/index.html>), which include frequent hand washing, covering your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze, and refraining from visiting if you are unwell or have reason to believe you may have been exposed to COVID-19.

As always, our top priority is the safety of our visitors, program participants, volunteers, and staff. We are taking additional steps to ensure the cleanliness of shared spaces and reduce the risk of illness for all visitors, program participants, volunteers, and employees.

We are in regular communication with city, county, and state health experts as we continue to monitor the situation. If circumstances should change, we will post updates to www.hosannahouse.org.
